Reminders:

Identification: Arco management now requires all volunteers to present a picture ID (ie: CDL) at the check-in entrance. This is for security reasons.

Dress Code: A white button-down-the-front shirt with a collar (no T-shirts, no polo shirts, no sort-of-white shirts), black trousers, and comfortable shoes (no open toes or heels). We will be on our feet for 4-5 hours. Arco Concessions will not accept any other dress code and will turn back volunteers not dressed properly. Arco Concessions will provide aprons and baseball caps for all workers.
